EXTREME WEATHER POLICY

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- When the weather is too wet, cold or windy or in extremely high temperatures, the following procedures will apply:
 1. Implementation of policy to be notified by administration member.
 2. All staff and students to remain indoors (or undercover ie to canteen, toilets etc straight there and back).
 3. Normal playground duty is suspended. Teachers will collaborate to ensure adequate supervision of all students in their block.
 4. Home classes to be supervised by teachers and support staff (using a buddy system)
 5. Suspension of the policy procedures will only occur when advised by admin.
 6. Staff to ensure all students supervised at all times.

These are designed to prevent students returning to class wet and/or cold and to minimize the risk of injury at these times.

- Students will be restricted to their home rooms only whilst extreme weather policy is in force. (ie students are not to visit other rooms)
- Extreme weather policy may be implemented at any time during wet or hot weather, and always during wet weather. No sport equipment is to be taken out. Teachers will be notified of this by a member of the administration team.
- Specialist Teacher - Specialist and support staff should eat their lunch and then move between classes to provide staff with the opportunity for a toilet / coffee – tea break. TA 11-19 PE staff, TA 21-28 Music Staff, TA 31-39 Visual Art Staff, TA 41- 48 – LOTE staff
- Please ensure that all students are reminded to be careful and sensible if allowed out as the grounds will be wet.
- Students returning to class wet are to be sent to administration immediately.
