Homework Policy

Homework is...families and the school working together to support student development. All families are strongly encouraged to engage in the homework process.

Homework will:

- consolidate skills and concepts taught at school
- increase family awareness of skills and concepts being developed in classroom programs
- provide opportunities for students to complete unfinished work
- provide opportunities for students to gather information to assist with classroom tasks
- support individual student programs, where applicable
- provide opportunities for students to develop research and study skills, time management skills and increasing independence and self discipline in relation to set tasks

Guidelines:

- All students from K-Year 6 will have a school diary
- All students from Year 1-6 will have homework posted on Connect whenever possible. Paper copies will be provided when Connect cannot be accessed.
- The school homework policy will be included in the student diary each year.
- Homework will be consistent across each year level.
- Homework should be marked through self-marking ie Pro-Literacy / Study Ladder, with a marking sheet provided by the teacher or marked by the teacher.
