Staggered Starts First Week Kindy

Dear Parents/Guardians,

With school due to return on Monday under the updated COVID-19 regulations, we will be aiming to make the transition for our Kindy students as smooth as possible.

There will be a limit of **10 adults per classroom** at any one time and we will be implementing a **staggered start to the day** and also asking that only **one adult per child** enters the classroom. This means that if there is more than one adult dropping off a child they will need to remain outside please. This process will ensure that every student will have time with a parent/carer at drop off. Please refer to the timetable below to see what time you will need to drop your child off next week.

Please note that the window of time is only **5 minutes** per group. We are hoping this will only be for one week (fingers crossed!). When the bell rings, we ask you to say goodbye to your child and leave quickly. Remember 'Tissues and Tim Tams' will still be running so you are welcome to head to the Library afterwards. The school will provide tea, coffee, Tim Tams and tissues. Please feel free to stay for a cuppa, a chat and shed a tear if you need, or rejoice in the ability to finish a hot cup of tea!

Please remember that all staff and parents must wear a mask on the school site. Please talk to your child about this to ease any uncertainties they may have. All parents and children will be required to sanitize their hands as they enter the class, and the children will receive regular reminders about hygiene throughout the day.

Although this is not the start we were hoping for with your beautiful children beginning Kindy, we are very excited to be back to school and can't wait to see them next week!
