EXTREME WEATHER POLICY

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- When the weather is too wet, cold or windy or in extremely high temperatures, the following procedures will apply:
 - 1. Implementation of policy to be notified by administration member.
 - 2. All staff and students to remain indoors (or undercover i.e. to canteen, toilets etc straight there and back).
 - 3. Normal playground duty is suspended. Teachers will collaborate to ensure adequate supervision of all students in their block.
 - 4. Home classes to be supervised by teachers and support staff (using a buddy system)
 - 5. When extreme weather is called it will remain in place for the duration of the break.
 - 6. Staff to ensure all students supervised at all times.
- Students will be restricted to their home rooms only whilst extreme weather policy is in force. (i.e. students are not to visit other rooms)
- A roster of specialist and administrative staff will be developed to provide a break for staff who do not have buddy arrangements (Transportable classes). The roster will include an EA to monitor movement in and around the canteen for the collection of lunches etc.
- Please ensure that all students are reminded to be careful and sensible if allowed out as the grounds will be wet.
