Speech Pathologist Workshops

Information Session about Lisps

In Term Two, Week Eight, Speech Pathologist, Michelle O'Donnell from Paeds Plus will be offering parents a short 45-minute orientation and education session at Currambine Primary School to provide information about lisps.

This workshop is designed to teach parents how to implement strategies to reduce a lisp in their children. This workshop will provide general advice about lisps, how Speech Pathologists typically treat lisps and strategies you can use at home.

- Knowledge and information about how lisps occur,
- Resources and activities to work with your child at home.
- How to help your child produce a clear sound.

We wish to remind those families who have not yet registered on the Compass School Manager App to please do so as soon as possible. As to date we have only had a quarter of our parents registering.


Compass will become a more efficient way for our families to give online permission and payment - no more lost paperwork or time needed to attend the front office.

Year Five and Six families should have received a notification regarding the Winter Carnival. Permissions and payment can now be done via this app.



Looking for a fun and healthy way to start your Thursday mornings? Join the Currambine Primary School Running Club!





Who is this for?

 It is being offered at Currambine Primary School to Parents of children from Kindergarten to and including, Year Two.

Triple P can help you:

- encourage behaviour you like
- deal with problem behaviour
- become confident as a parent
- be realistic about parenting
- take care of yourself

Is this you?

Most of the time, parenting is great fun. You know you are doing a good job. But there are times when things get a little tricky.

Like when your toddler won't eat her dinner. Or your six-year-old won't pick up his toys. Maybe your child never seems to listen. If only someone could give you some ideas to make those times easier!

If this sounds like you, then Triple P Seminars may suit.

What are Triple P Seminars?

Triple P Seminars are for groups of parents. They're informal presentations, a little like a public forum.
